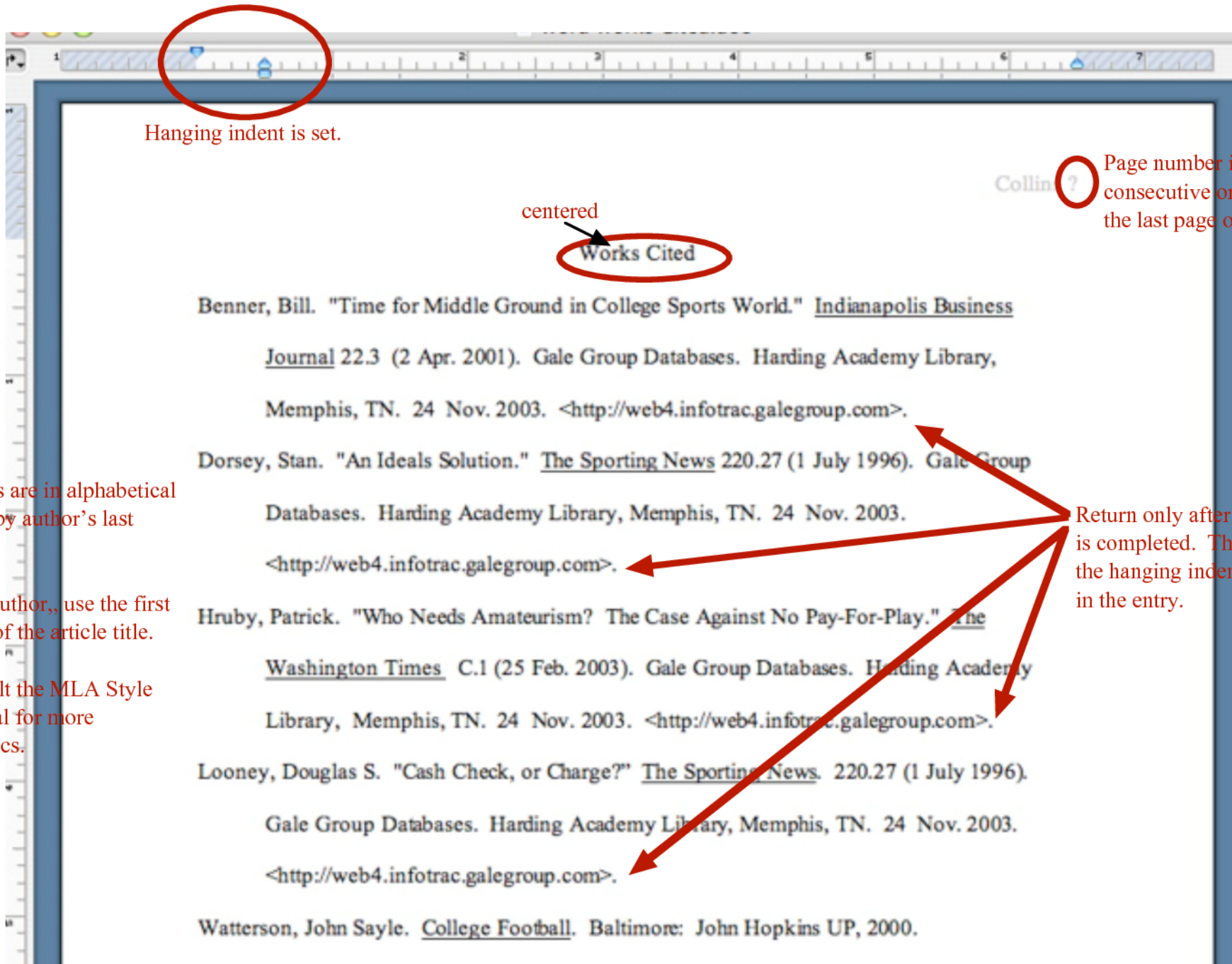

Return only after an entry is completed. This allows the hanging indent to work in the entry.
